A separate application will be required each week since at this time there is currently no way of knowing if the Provincial Health Guidelines or regulations will change from week to week. Site manager will be available at Bean Drinkin' Café patio from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM for any last minute challenges or questions. Reservations and payments will be accepted for subsequent dates at that time as well.

The stalls will be expected to be set up by 8:30. Parking lot closes at 9:00.

Until such time as the CRD Saturday market opens, unloading access on the Centennial Park side, adjacent to the park, will be available.

On the creek/estuary side of the building, unloading will be restricted to the area west/streetside of the propane tank storage area.

All parking by vendors must be off site. Cleanup and move out by 4:00 PM. Please ensure you take all garbage/belongings.

Requirements of vendors – Hand sanitizer for customers, and social distancing awareness at all times.
